**Recommendation R-01**. The Grand Jury recommends the County and each of the cities within the County coordinate their respective ordinances regarding massage parlors through the efforts of the Task Force. (C-04, C-03)

Response to R-01: The City's Police Department is currently part of the Bureau of Justice Human Trafficking Task Force. The next meeting, scheduled for August 11, 2020, will be focused on developing the Ventura County Human Trafficking Protocol. Simi Valley Police will contribute to the development of that protocol.
