Requested an update on the VCPWA Saticoy Pavement Project and an update on the California Transportation Grant Cycle 6 Active Transportation from the clerk or a team member from VCPWA.

Council member Teri Hernandez commented on the ownership of a public sound wall on Wells Rd (118 HWY). The council discussed several community options for the maintenance of the wall. The direction from the council was to find the owner of the wall and see if a community mural could be added to help stop future vandalism. Council member Josh Addison suggested a field trip to the Bell Arts Building in Ventura. The visit would help with mural options.

Alternate Council Member Dan Feliz commented on the local Art organization known as The LAB is closed and stated that during the successful X-Games event in Ventura, the longest line for food was the local business in Saticoy 'Happy Place' Food Truck, and finally announced the launch schedule of the Space X planned orbital mission was anticipated during the hours of 9P – 3A.
