

SANTA ROSA VALLEY MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL MINUTES
March 16, 2017

**The Santa Rosa Valley MAC held a Meeting on Thursday, March 16, 2017
at 6:00 p.m. at the Rancho Santa Rosa Property Owners' Association Club House,
11701 East Las Posas Road, Camarillo, CA 93012**

1. Call to Order

Chair Rosemary Allison called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm. **Mark Burley, Kevin Cannon,** and **Ruth Means** were present. **Janis Gardner** was absent.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Gusie Woodfill led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Agenda Review

No changes were made. **Ruth Means** moved to approve the agenda. It was seconded by **Mark Burley** and passed 4-0.

4. Public Safety Reports

CHP Officer Musgrove reported on the accident statistics for that past three years. Accidents on Santa Rosa Road and surrounding streets have decreased from 40 in 2014 to 38 in 2015 to 26 in 2016. In 2016, there were no DUI-caused accidents. **Ventura County Sheriff Senior Deputy Kathleen Perea** reported that nothing significant has happened in the Santa Rosa Valley during the past two months. There have been some residential burglaries in Moorpark and Camarillo. She reminded everyone to lock their doors and set their alarms at home and on their cars.

5. Approval of Minutes from January 19, 2017

Mark Burley moved to approve the January 19th minutes. **Ruth Means** seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

6. Comments of Ventura County Supervisor Linda Parks

Damon Wing from Supervisor Parks' office reported that Supervisor Parks followed up on the malfunctioning pedestrian crossing signals on Santa Rosa Road at the intersection of Vista Arroyo Drive and at the intersection of Blanchard Road. The Transportation Department sent a signal maintenance technician out to repair them. On January 24th, at the intersection of Santa Rosa Road and Vista Arroyo Drive, all pedestrian crossing signals were replaced. The pedestrian crossing signals at the intersection of Santa Rosa Road and Blanchard Road were checked on January 23rd and found to be working properly. We also followed up on the street sign for Santa Rosa Road and Jennifer Place that was knocked down, as well as the misspelled sign for East Las Posas Road. The Jennifer Place and East Las Posas Road signs were replaced on January 24th. Damon also announced that on Sunday, April 23rd, the Simi Landfill will be providing a free residential drop-off day that is open to residents of the Santa Rosa Valley.

7. Council Comments on Issues Not on the Agenda

Mark Burley said that with the recent reports on glyphosate being a carcinogen, he wondered what the Watershed Protection District used and asked if there is a database of all of the herbicide and pesticides that the WPD sprays into the watershed on an annual basis. **Damon Wing** said he would check with WPD and report back. **Ruth Means** said that she would like to have a follow-up discussion about Santa Rosa Road traffic calming that would serve the residents of the Santa

Rosa Valley. **Kevin Cannon** asked if the MAC could get updates on proposed development projects in the Santa Rosa Valley. He also asked if the Transportation Department could put up notification signs in advance of road repair work so that drivers could be made aware of the road construction ahead of them. **Rosemary Allison** announced that April 1st is the date for the Santa Rosa School fundraising dinner dance.

8. Public Comments on Items Not on the Agenda

Gusie Woodfill reported several sightings of rattlesnakes in Santa Rosa Park and around the hills and yards in the Barranca Road area, and she noted that they are out earlier in the year than usual. She urged everyone to keep an eye out for them, especially when young children or pets are playing in the grass. **Damon Wing** said that he would let the County Parks Department know about the snakes.

The date and logistics are still being worked out.
