Whereas, JASON FULLER BEGAN HIS CAREER WITH THE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AS A CADET IN 1988 AND LATER SERVED ON THE SHERIFF'S SEARCH AND RESCUE TEAM; AND

Whereas, HE WAS HIRED AS A SHERIFF'S SERVICE TECHNICIAN IN 1998 AND ENTERED THE SHERIFF'S ACADEMY IN 1999, GRADUATING WITH CLASS 99-1 BEFORE BEGINNING HIS CAREER AT THE TODD ROAD JAIL; AND

Whereas, JASON TRANSFERRED TO EAST COUNTY PATROL SERVICES IN 2001, SERVING AT THE THOUSAND OAKS STATION UNTIL 2015, WHERE HE PROTECTED AND SERVED RESIDENTS WITH DISTINCTION; AND

Whereas, HE WAS SELECTED FOR THE SHIFT LEAD DEPUTY PROGRAM IN 2015, RECEIVING COMMENDATIONS FOR HIS OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE AND CONTINUING TO SERVE IN VARIOUS LEADERSHIP ROLES WITHIN THE PRE-TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY; AND

Whereas, JASON RETURNED TO PATROL AT THE THOUSAND OAKS STATION IN 2018, WAS PROMOTED TO SENIOR DEPUTY IN 2020, AND SERVED AS A SUPERVISOR AT BOTH THE PRE-TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY AND THE MOORPARK PATROL STATION; AND

Whereas, JASON RETURNED TO PATROL AT THE THOUSAND OAKS STATION IN 2018, WAS PROMOTED TO SENIOR DEPUTY IN 2020, AND SERVED AS A SUPERVISOR AT BOTH THE PRE-TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY AND THE MOORPARK PATROL STATION; AND
