The Assessment Appeals Board ensures all applicants receive a fair and impartial hearing in which the Board has jurisdiction to determine taxable value of a property, remove assessment penalties, determine if or when a property changed ownership, determine the classification of a property, and determine if an assessment appeal application is valid. Without an Assessment Appeals Board, the Board of Supervisors would serve as the Local Board of Equalization.

Qualifications: To be eligible for membership on the Appeals Board or serve as an alternate, a person must have a minimum of five years professional experience in California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant, licensed real estate broker, property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, or be a person who the nominating Board of Supervisors' member has reason to believe possess a competent knowledge of property appraisal and taxation (Rev. & Tax. Code Section 1624).

Assessment Appeals Hearing Officer

Purpose: The Assessment Appeals Hearing Officer serves as an alternative to an Assessment Appeals Board hearing, available to Owners of Single-Family Residences and other properties when assessed under \$500,000. The purpose is to provide the average self-represented Taxpayer with a less formal alternative to a hearing with the full Assessment Appeals Board. The Hearing Officer is tasked with equalization of assessment values determined by the County Assessor's Office for those Taxpayers who file an Assessment Appeal Application with the Clerk of the Board's Office and choose to be heard by the Hearing Officer. The Hearing Officer ensures all applicants receive a fair and impartial hearing in which the Hearing Officer has jurisdiction to determine taxable value of a property, remove assessment penalties, determine if or when a property changed ownership, and determine the classification of a property. Without an Assessment Appeals Hearing Officer, all matters would be heard by an Assessment Appeals Board, or, in the Absence of an Assessment Appeals Board, by the Board of Supervisors serving as the Local Board of Equalization.

Qualifications: Revenue and Taxation Code Sections 1624.05 and 1624.1 and must successfully complete the mandatory training.

Behavioral Health Advisory Board

Purpose: The purpose is provided in Section 5604.2 of the Welfare and Institutions Code and include but are not limited to: Review and evaluate the community's behavioral health needs, including housing, services, facilities, and special problems to ensure that services are provided that promote wellness and recovery, improving and maintaining the health and safety of individuals, families and communities affected by mental health and/or substance abuse issues. Advise the Board of Supervisors and the Behavioral Health Department Director as to any aspect of the County's mental health and substance use disorder treatment and prevention services.

Qualifications: The mental health representatives and substance use disorder representative should have some experience and knowledge of the behavioral health system.

Membership No less than 15 and no more than 23 Members:

- 50% or more should be consumers or the parents, spouses, siblings, or adult children of consumers who are receiving or have received mental health services.

- At least 20% (i.e., 5 members) shall be consumers.

- One member shall be recommended to the BOS by the Ventura County Sheriff to represent law enforcement.

- One practicing psychiatrist recommended by the Southern California Psychiatric Society.

- Chair must be elected by a majority of votes of BHAB Members.

Remote Access Network (RAN) Board

Purpose: Within each county or group of counties eligible to receive funding under the department's master plan for equipment, that elects to participate in the Remote Access Network, a local RAN board shall be established. Where a single county is eligible to receive funding, that county's RAN board shall be the local RAN board. Where a group of counties is eligible for funding, the local RAN board shall consist of a regional board. The RAN board shall determine the placement of RAN equipment within the county or counties, and coordinate acceptance, delivery, and installation of RAN equipment. The board shall also develop any procedures necessary to regulate the ongoing use and maintenance of that equipment, adhering to the policy guidelines and procedures adopted by the department. The local board shall consider placement of equipment on the basis of the following criteria:

- (1) The crime rate of the jurisdiction or jurisdictions served by the agency.
- (2) The number of criminal offenses reported by the agency or agencies to the department.
- (3) The potential number of fingerprint cards and latent fingerprints processed.
- (4) The number of sworn personnel of the agency or agencies.

Membership Information: Each RAN board shall be composed of seven members, as follows: a member of the board of supervisors, the sheriff, the district attorney, the chief of police of the Cal-ID member department having the largest number of sworn personnel within the county, a second chief selected by all other police chiefs within the county, a mayor elected by the city selection committee established pursuant to Section 50270 of the Government Code, and a member-at-large chosen by the other members. In any county lacking two chiefs of police, a substitute member shall be selected by the other members on the board. Groups of counties forming a region shall establish a seven-member board with each county having equal representation on the board and at least one member-at-large. If the number of participating counties precludes equal representation on a seven-member board, the size of the board shall be expanded so that each county has at least two representatives and there is a single member-at-large.

Representation of a broad array of stakeholders on the Alliance Board will enhance the capacity to coordinate and leverage resources from various community sectors throughout the Region. To this end, the Alliance will strategically pursue a Governance Board that represents the array of stakeholders, the diverse geographic sub-regions, and the constituency for whom each seat is designated. Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing (HEARTH) regulations require the Board to be representative of the relevant organizations and of projects serving homeless subpopulations within the Continuum of Care's geographic area and that includes at least one homeless or formerly homeless individual to act on its behalf.

Qualifications: Alliance Board Members are selected to represent various constituencies. In order to adequately represent that constituency, Board Members shall meet basic qualifications including the following:

- A. Meet eligibility to be a voting Member;
- B. Sufficient knowledge and a working relationship with the constituency group;

- D. Ability to work effectively on a team;
- E. Capacity to consider the benefit of the Alliance as a whole;
- F. Ability to meet the timelines/demands of funding sources;
- G. Respectful acknowledgement of the rights of homeless persons; and
- H. Eligible to conduct business with a governmental entity (i.e., not debarred or suspended).
