

SUPERVISORIAL REDISTRICTING

How you can participate in the process

The County of Ventura's Board of Supervisors has started the redistricting process to balance the population in each of the County's five supervisorial districts. The redrawing of district lines occurs every 10 years with the release of new U.S. Census data and ensures that each Board member represents about the same number of residents.

County residents are encouraged to participate in the process to share with the Board of Supervisors how you think district boundaries should be drawn to best represent your community.

Choose how you would like to participate:

Visit the County website at ventura.org/redistricting to:

- Submit a Community Input Form that asks 4 questions to describe your community, where it is located, and why keeping your community together ensures fair and effective representation with the Board of Supervisors.
- Use the digital map to define your community or propose district boundaries.
