As required by California Penal Code section 933.05, this letter is a response to the findings and recommendations of the 2002-2003 Ventura County Grand Jury's Report entitled Fleet Maintenance for County Vehicle. The following is my response to :

Findings and Recommendations:

- R-2 Establish a credit card system charged directly to the using agency for fuel costs.
- R-3 Use information gathered from Camarillo vendor maintenance data to compare with GSA maintenance data.

In reviewing the above noted recommendations, we concur that R-2 and R-3 are necessary, and have been discussed with GSA staff in ongoing meetings. A decision to implement a method which reflects current market fuel rates, along with investigating the use of private vendors for police vehicles are being looked into.
