## Recommendations numbered R-01, R-02, R-04 have been implemented:

According to the Grand Jury report dated June 7, 2012, FA-09 describes how Moorpark Unified School District already complies with all of the Grand Jury findings, FI-01 through FI-05. Recommendations R-01, R-02 and R-04 suggest that all school districts should continue doing what they are currently doing.

**R-01:** Moorpark Unified School District will continue to review and update our CSSP and EDP annually as required by California Education Code.

**R-02:** Moorpark Unified School District will continue to conduct safety drills and safety inspections as required by California Education Code, State Law and Ventura County Schools Self Funding Authority annual requirements.

**R-04:** Moorpark Unified School District will continue to maintain our emergency supplies and equipment as suggested by Ventura County Schools Self Funding Authority recommendations.
