The staff of the City of Ojai has discussed the following recommendations and will take the actions described to study the applicability in the City of Ojai:

R-01. Cities should aggressively pursue the recovery of costs from the individual(s) convicted of graffiti vandalism.

The City will request that the District Attorney seek restitution orders with future prosecutions.

R-04. The Cities should enlist the assistance of volunteer groups within the County for graffiti abatement. Such groups might include: Sheriff's and Youth Graffiti Removal Incident Team; Keep America Beautiful; and various civic groups.

With the limited number of graffiti incidents in Ojai we have found that a quick response by City crews is faster and more efficient, and takes fewer resources than recruiting and supervising volunteers.

R-05. The Cities, with the exception of Port Hueneme and Santa Paula, should amend their city codes regarding graffiti vandalism to include provisions for the city to petition the sentencing court for the delay or suspension of driving privileges for those convicted of graffiti vandalism, as allowed for in the state vehicle code

It is the responsibility of the courts to follow the protocol for suspension of driving privileges.
