- With regard to the Report's findings, the City Council accepts those findings pertaining to the City of Port Hueneme, however, a response was not requested from Gold Coast Transit, Inc. of which Port Hueneme is a member agency through a Joint Powers Agreement with the cities of Ojai, Oxnard, Ventura, and the County of Ventura.
