#### AND CITY OF MOORPARK CITY COUNCIL RESPONSES

## **GRAND JURY FINDING FI-01:**

The Grand Jury rated all holding cells in the County as satisfactory or better for the areas reviewed with the exception of:

- The Oxnard Police holding cell area was dirty
- The Moorpark police station internal camera system was inoperative

#### CITY COUNCIL RESPONSE TO FINDING FI-01 & RECOMMENDATION R-04

The Ventura County Sheriff's Office (VCSO) is the contract law enforcement agency for the City of Moorpark. VCSO has agreed to replace the entire internal camera system. Funds have already been secured and the camera system should be installed and operational by July of 2016.
