

FINDINGS/ CONCLUSIONS

C-04. If the format of online information was consistent, the citizens of the County would be able to easily compare records of monetary contributions made to candidates for public office. The City of Simi Valley has the most user-friendly format regarding monetary contributions online.

The City partially agrees with conclusions of C-04. Reports provided online are in redacted form therefore are not providing full disclosure to the public.

R-02. The Grand Jury recommends that all cities within the County (Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Santa Paula, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, and Ventura) direct staff to establish a direct link on their website homepage for public online access to records of all monetary contributions made to their candidates for public office.

Response to R-02

The City will establish on the City's website general information to the public about campaign reporting and explain how to obtain access to unredacted copies of filings through the City Clerk's Office either in person or via e-mail.
