The VCWMA is an expansion of the former Ventura County Arundo Task Force (VCATF). The VCWMA's activities focus upon the exclusion, detection, eradication, and suppression of priority noxious and invasive weeds using an integrated approach. The Ventura County Weed Management Area group meets approximately 4 times per year.
