B11 assumed Sentinel IC from ME47 with approximately 1 acre with an initial threat to structures.

Divs. A, M, and Z established w/ priority going direct and perimeter control.

2nd alarm requested due to fire outpacing 1st alarm resources.

Copter 4 assumed Helco w/ Cpt. 5 and HT40 going direct with DIV's.

AT52 assumed Sentinel AirAttack w/ T73 and T163 with the priority of going direct at the head of the fire to connect the last 200 yrds. of open line so fire would not get established and run to structures on Anderson St.

Ventura and Cam Crews 1/3 and 2/4 assisted with line construction and mop-up.

Crew 14 direct line and Mop-up.

Dozer 14 constructed line for all Divs.

Pr12 with Pr14, Pr44, Pr37 and Pr39 handled Logistics.

Fire mapped at 4.88 acres.

C-12 with Ryan Walker assumed IC as ICT4 with E357 at 2035 hrs.
 Fire placed in Patrol status and declared Fire Out at 1030 hrs. 6/29/24 by ME47.

ME47 arrived on scene with no access to the fire. Fire was approx 50-80 yards from driveway. FF 47 jumped fence and said the fire was 100x100. upon making access through fence, fire had grown to 1/2 acre moving uphill to the west. wind then pushed the fire south and into alignment where the fire grew to several acres. engine crews and hand crews went direct to the fire with progressive hose lays and line. fire was stopped to just under 6 acres. C12 became IC with E357 for the night. incident closed at 06/29/24, 1030 by ME47 after visual inspection of line and burn area.
