

If your city has a Social Host Ordinance that applies to fireworks, what is the date it was adopted and what are the initial and subsequent fines?

Adopted 7/16/18, fines are set in accordance with Division 1 Chapter 1.50, \$132 fine for initial violation (\$264 subsequent, and \$396 for a third violation), or enforceable as a misdemeanor.

• What clearances and licenses (FAA or otherwise) are required for you to fly drones?

VPD's drone program currently operates under FAA Part 107 regulations, and all department drone operators hold current FAA remote pilot certificates. However, the department also currently holds a COA, or Certificate of Authorization, which is an authorization issued by the FAA that allows a public agency to operate drones for a specific activity, in this case, law enforcement and emergency management purposes within the City Limits of Ventura.

• How many drones does your department own currently?

The department is authorized to have up to 25 drones. The number of operational drones at any given time varies significantly, but, in general, approximately 12 miniature and three enterprise grade drones are deployable.
