RESOLUTION NO. 24-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI  
RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, DECLARING THE PERSONS ELECTED  
AS MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL MEMBER FOR DISTRICT 4, CITY CLERK, AND CITY  
TREASURER, OF THE CITY OF OJAI, AND DECLARING THE RESULT IN THE  
ELECTION REGARDING MEASURE “O”**

**WHEREAS**, a duly noticed General Municipal Election was held in the City of Ojai on November 5, 2024, for the purpose of voting for candidates for one (1) full-term (two years) office of Mayor; for one (1) full-term office of Council Member for District 4, one (1) full-term office of City Clerk, one (1) full-term office of City Treasurer, and one (1) ballot measure, Measure “O”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 24-18 the City Council requested the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura to consolidate the General Municipal Election with the General Election to be held on the same date pursuant to §10403 of the Elections Code; and

**WHEREAS**, for a consolidated election, the City Clerk, upon receipt of the results of the election from the County of Ventura Elections Official conducting the election, shall certify the results to the governing body; and

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA,  
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the General Municipal Election for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates as required by law for the following City Offices: Members of the City Council for District 4 and the Mayor; the City Clerk, and the City Treasurer, was duly held on Tuesday, November 5, 2025, and the votes cast, including the Vote by Mail ballots issued in connection with the election which were returned at the time and in the form and manner required by law were all duly and regularly canvassed. That the Ventura County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk has duly canvassed the returns of the election and filed the Certificate of Canvass with the City Council and from that certification the City Council finds that the total number of votes cast in each district, the total number of votes cast in each of the respective election precincts established for the election, the number of votes cast for each candidate in each precinct and the total number of votes for each candidate, are as provided in Exhibit “A”, attached hereto and made a part of this resolution. Exhibit “A” is true and correct copy of the canvass of the votes cast in the City of Ojai at the General Municipal Election.

**SECTION 2.** The following candidate for the office of Mayor of the City of Ojai received a majority of votes cast, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, is therefore declared to be the Mayor duly elected to serve on the Ojai City Council until December 2026:

**Andy Gilman**

**SECTION 3.** The following candidate for the office of Member of the City Council for District 4 received a majority of votes cast, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, is therefore declared to be a Council Member duly elected to serve on the Ojai City Council for District 4 until December 2028:

**Kim Sofley-Mang**

**SECTION 4.** The following candidate for the office of City Clerk received a majority of votes cast, and in accordance with the provision of law governing the nomination and/or election of candidates for this office, and is therefore declared to be City Clerk duly elected to serve as City Clerk until December 2028:

**Steve Quilici**

**SECTION 5.** The following candidate for the office of City Treasurer received the highest number of votes and is therefore declared to be City Treasurer duly elected to serve until December 2028:

**Steve Olsen**

**SECTION 6.** Initiative Measure “O”.

- A. Measure “O” appeared on the ballot as follows: “Shall an ordinance requiring the four pickleball courts at the Ojai City Hall, 401 South Ventura Street, Ojai California, to be kept open to the public year-round, without any other City permission or permits, and implementing sound mitigation and adverse impacts efforts, be adopted?”
- B. Measure “O” received an affirmative vote of more than a majority of the votes cast, and therefore was approved and passed by the voters.
- C. The City Council hereby declares the Measure “O” was approved and passed by the voters.

**SECTION 7.** The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council a statement of the results of the election, showing the whole number of votes cast in the City, the names of the persons voted for, the offices each person ran for, the number of votes given on Election Day and by absentee voters to each person, and the total number of votes given each person and ballot measure. Acting under the law, the Ventura County Clerk-Recorder, Registrar of Voters deemed the November 5, 2024, General Election a vote-by-mail or at vote centers election. Therefore, the

total ballots case at the City of Ojai General Municipal Election held on November 5, 2024, are as reported in Exhibit A, to this Resolution.

**SECTION 8.** The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each person so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; and the City Clerk shall administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

**SECTION 9.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

**SECTION 10.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
