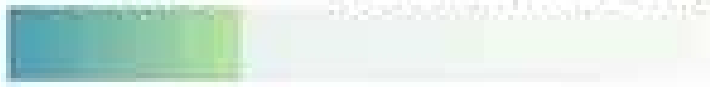


## Heat risk in Ventura, CA

The number of the hottest days in Ventura is projected to keep increasing.

Risk rating is relative to the contiguous U.S. and is based on extreme heat risk through 2050. Even places with low risk ratings can expect an increased number of the hottest days per year.

In a typical year around 1990, people in Ventura, CA experienced about **7** days above **89.9°F** in a year. By 2050, people in Ventura are projected to experience an average of about **27** days per year over 89.9°F.
